ASSISTANT PROPERTY APPRAISER

QUALIFICATIONS

Either I

One year of experience in California state service performing property appraisal duties of a class equivalent to Junior Property Appraiser. (Applicants who are within six months of meeting this requirement will be admitted to the examination, but must satisfactorily meet this requirement before they can be considered eligible for appointment.)

Or II

Experience: Either

- 1. Two years of experience performing real property appraisal duties in an assessor's office; or
- Three years of experience appraising real property. (Experience in real estate sales or transfers is not considered as qualifying experience under this requirement.)

AND

Education: Equivalent to graduation from college. (Additional qualifying experience or experience in real property management, mortgage lending, title work, structural cost estimating, or real estate practice may be substituted for the required education on a year-for-year basis.)

(Experience in California state service applied toward Pattern II must include one year of experience performing the duties of a class at a level of responsibility equivalent to Junior Property Appraiser.)



Typical Responsibilities

The Assistant Property Appraiser provides great potential for personal development and career advancement. Under direct supervision, incumbents collaboratively conduct the less complex appraisals and field audits of all types of real property. Work as a member of a survey team, traveling throughout California, to assist with a wide range of property tax appraisal assignments as well as challenging property tax research projects. You will have support from your team members and supervisor. Incumbent must have knowledge of factors involved in the appraisal of real property and of the principles underlying the appraisal process; real property law; provisions of the State Constitution and the Revenue and Taxation Code pertaining to the assessment of property for tax purposes; purposes. organization, and procedures of local assessors' offices; real property appraisal for tax assessment purposes; common methods of describing real property.

The successful candidate will be part of a survey audit team with oversight of all 58 County Assessors' offices. Your experience may include the following:

- Travel throughout California up to 50 percent of the time.
- Participate in meetings with County Assessors and staff.
- Audit Assessor's records and report findings via written reports.
- Make recommendations for tax law compliance.
- Work as a team or independently.
