The hearing provides taxpayers, assessors, or other local agencies with the opportunity to provide comments on items discussed in the State Board of Equalization's Taxpayers' Rights Advocate's Annual Report, identify means to correct any problems described in the report, and to comment on all Board-administered programs or local property tax issues.
