One of the requirements for being a Property Appraiser with the State Board of Equalization is that the candidate must hold a valid *Appraisers Certificate for Property Tax Purposes*. Do you currently hold a valid Appraisers Certificate? Describe some of your experience with the working with the Board.

The Senior Specialist Property Appraiser is required to act as a leadperson for a team that conducts compliance audits of the various California County Assessors' offices. Describe experience you had in acting as a leadperson on a project similar to an audit of a county office?

The Senior Specialist Property Appraiser is required to conduct those portions of the compliance audit of a California County Assessor's office that deal with the most complex property tax statutes and advanced appraisal theories. Describe education/experience you have had with appraising property in California under the current property tax laws (Proposition 13)?

The Senior Specialist Property Appraiser is required to research and write technical documents on complex property tax issues. Describe examples of how you assessed new construction and change in ownership under Proposition 13.

Describe your experience with assessing possessory interests.
