Subject: Building Update - Sidewalk Closure and Food Truck Schedule

Board of Equalization (BOE) Headquarters (HQ) Building 5th Street Sidewalk Closure

As a result of the spandrel panel failure on January 11, 2012, the sidewalk along the 5th street perimeter of the BOE HQ remains closed to foot traffic.

We again ask employees to avoid any potential issues with the 5th street sidewalk by not crossing under the taped area by utilizing alternatives paths of travel.

The protective barriers and caution tape are to remain in place until BOE receives a formal response from the Department of General Services (DGS) as to the cause of the window failure. Should a BOE employee enter the taped area, his or her immediate supervisor may be notified to advise the employee that these requirements are in place as an additional safeguard to assure our employees' health and safety.

BOE is tracking all issues with the spandrel glass panel failure and has requested that DGS provide a report of findings from its Forensic Architect, McGinnis Chen and Associates.

In addition, BOE has requested that DGS obtain a structural engineering firm to investigate the window failure and provide a report as to the cause of the spandrel panel failure.

FOOD TRUCK SCHEDULE – February 6 to February 10, 2012

As a continued result of the temporary closure of the Board of Equalization (BOE) Headquarters cafeteria, this past week BOE was successful in contacting a variety of Sacramento Food Truck Service vendors to provide hot food service for BOE employees while the cafeteria remains closed.

Starting next Monday, February 6 through Friday February 10, 2012, BOE staff will again be able to purchase hot food daily from a variety of food trucks. Please note that due to external issues this past week with some food truck vendors, the original schedule as submitted to BOE was subject to unforeseen change. The weekly schedule as submitted to BOE will be posted each week on eBOE until the cafeteria re-opens and please remember it is subject to change.

Food trucks as listed on the schedule below will serve a breakfast menu to BOE employees from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and then serve a lunch menu from 10.30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Due to the fact that trucks are limited for breakfast at this time, next week's service is limited to one day.

There will be two (2) to three (3) food trucks parked in front of the building at the main entrance on N Street. Note that there is additional space for vendors to park on the ground floor in the parking garage at the corner of 4th and O Streets.

In addition, coffee service, sandwiches, and salads are still available at the coffee kiosk area from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The cafeteria seating area is open and vending services are also available.

For those interested in the CAL PERS cafeteria and menu, the link is attached at the very bottom of this message.

Please know BOE is working diligently to obtain a new cafeteria vendor. We hope to have the new vendor in place and re-open the cafeteria in the near future.
