Regarding: 22ND Floor Sampling Protocol

Dear Mr. Gau:

Hygiene Technologies International, Inc. (HygieneTech) was recently notified that the State of California Board of Equalization (BOE) would like to temporarily reoccupy the 22nd Floor to accommodate proposed repair/remediation work by the State of California Department of General Services (DGS) within the BOE building. The BOE plans to use the 22nd Floor as a swing floor to temporarily relocate staff from other floors so those floors can be emptied to facilitate the DGS proposed work. To ensure the health and safety of the BOE staff while working on the 22nd Floor, we would intend to collect varying area air samples throughout the floor. We would also be prepared to use a direct-reading instrument to record airborne levels of carbon dioxide, relative humidity, and temperature. All air samples and an appropriate number of blanks (identical media through which no air is drawn), if needed, would be analyzed at laboratories accredited by the American Industrial Hygiene Association. The following types of samples will be collected in order to determine building occupant exposure potentials:

- Airborne total fungi analyses;
- Airborne total dust analyses;
- Airborne fibrous dust analyses;
- Airborne 4-phenylcyclohexane analyses (possible emission from new carpet);
- Although we currently have no plans to collect surface fungi samples, we may do so if circumstances dictate the need.
