**Subject:** Building Update - Wind Dancer Moving Truck Fuel Leak at 4th and N Streets

## **BUILDING UPDATE – WIND DANCER MOVING TRUCK FUEL LEAK AT 4<sup>th</sup> and N STREET**

At approximately 10:45 a.m. this morning, a Board of Equalization (BOE) employee notified the Guard Station in the 450 N Street building that a Wind Dancer Moving truck, parked near the corner of 4<sup>th</sup> and N Streets, had a diesel fuel leak. The Department of General Services (DGS) property manager and the Sacramento Fire Department (SFD) were immediately contacted.

At approximately 11:00 a.m., the DGS placed protective sand at the edges of the leak and the SFD arrived on scene. Pedestrians who were near the fuel leak were redirected until the leak could be controlled. The SFD immediately neutralized the approximate 3 to 5 gallons of fuel on the curb with an absorbent powder. The SFD then contacted the SFD Hazmat team which arrived on scene at 12:00 p.m.

At 12:10 p.m., the leak was stopped and Wind Dancer moved their truck from the area. At 12:30 p.m., the SFD Hazmat team removed the sand and related fuel absorbent and conducted final clean-up of the affected area. No interruption occurred to BOE business or the Discovery Tree Day Care Center in the 450 N Street building.
