**II. WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN (WIC) PROGRAM**

September 11, 2007

**A. Discussion and Recommendation for Board Action:**

Current WIC Program requirement that infant formula suppliers hold a valid seller's permit.

**Staff Recommendation:** Since some suppliers of infant formula are not required to hold seller's permits (under the Sales and Use Tax law) and that the possession of a valid seller's permit does not ensure that only legitimate businesses will sell infant formula, staff is willing to (1) work with the CDPH to find ways to revise its guidelines to meet its objectives while either eliminating or modifying the seller's permit requirement, and (2) report back to the Committee in December on the results of that meeting. In the meantime, the staff recommends that the Board not revoke any WIC infant formula suppliers' seller's permits on the basis that the supplier only sells nontaxable food products, until such time as the issue can be addressed with the CDPH.
