The bill, as amended, is no longer within the scope of responsibility of the Board.

COMMENT

Among other things, the amendments delete the provisions that would have increased, on and after January 1, 2012, the IWM fee to \$2.13 per ton, and also authorized the California Department of Resource Recycling and Recovery to adjust the fee not more than once every two years to reflect increases or decreases in the cost of living during the prior two fiscal years as measured by the California Consumer Price Index issued by the Department of Industrial Relations or a successor agency.

The bill now would revise the definition of “renderer” for purposes of the California Meant and Poultry Inspection Act, and similarly revise the definition of “rendering.”
