RE: Veteran's Tax Exemption Issue

Dear Chairperson,

We are contacting your office, to request all monies taken in error by the State Board of Equalization be returned to all Veteran Vendors who come under Senate Bill 809 and Senate Bill 805.

These disabled veterans deserve the benefit afforded them by the enactment of March 23, 1892. The past 20 years the State of California has refused to honor the law. Many veterans have come before the S.B.O.E. only to be told that the law is written poorly and does not mean what the law says. It is well past time to correct this injustice. The plain meaning of the law must be followed.

It is our position that the monies taken, be returned, the costs of bringing this issue forward, as well as all legal fees, travel, and associated monies spent to have the March 23, 1892 enactment fully recognized, to include all interest on such money. This demand for those monies taken, must be returned.

Those S.B.O.E. Veteran hearings must be set aside and a full explanation be offered to all involved. The American people owe a debt that can never be repaid in full, to our Veterans. Let no one forget the Veteran, Honor the law. A reply is requested.
