WHEREAS, Linda S. Knox, Administrative Assistant II in the Administration Department's Deputy Director's Office, will retire on April 1, 2016, after twenty-five years of outstanding and meritorious service to the State of California and the California State Board of Equalization; and

Then, in June 2008, transferred to the Administration Department as an Administrative Assistant II where she enjoyed nine years before her retirement; and
