WHEREAS, Sharon Runner was a devoted wife and partner to her husband, Board of Equalization Member George Runner, and dedicated mother and grandmother; and

WHEREAS, Sharon Runner's most notable public policy achievement was co-authoring Jessica's Law with her husband George, one of the strongest laws enacted to protect our children from sexual predators; and

WHEREAS, Sharon Runner was a strong advocate for public safety, education and children's issues in both the California State Assembly and Senate from 2002 to 2008 and 2011 to 2016, respectively; and

WHEREAS, Sharon Runner's public service encompassed many exceptional accomplishments, such as co-founding Desert Christian Schools; serving as President of California Women Lead and Political Action Committee Chair of the California Women's Leadership Association; volunteering for Donate Life California, the National Scleroderma Foundation, and serving on the Sierra Donor Services Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Sharon Runner also worked with charter schools, developing programs to help at-risk students achieve academic success, and the United Way, Antelope Valley Hospital Gift Foundation, Healthy Homes Advisory Council, and Care Net, a pregnancy resource center: Therefore be it resolved.
