Item P3.1 -Business Tax and Fee Deputy Director's Report

In accordance with the Health and Safety Code sections listed below, the tax and fees administered under the Hazardous Substances Tax Law are adjusted each year by the incremental change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) published by the California Department of Industrial Relations. The increase in the CPI from June 30, 2015 to June 30, 2016 is 2,109 percent and was calculated as follows:

CPI @ June 30, 2016	255 684
CPI @ June 30, 2015	250.404
Increase in CPI	5.280
Percentage Increase	2 109%

Based on the change in the CPI, the 2017 calendar year rates for the tax and fee programs administered under the Hazardous Substances Tax Law will be established according to the attached schedules identified as Exhibits A - C:
