Board staff will hold an interested parties meeting to discuss whether the Board of Equalization should authorize publication of a new regulation to provide guidelines on the documentation and retention requirements for transfers of cigarette and tobacco products between retail stores owned by the same legal entity and amend existing regulations to clarify the issuance of a notice of suspension and notice of revocation, and to allow flexibility in reducing a suspension period.
