

Pursuant to Section 155 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, I respectfully request a 30-day extension of time beyond July 1, 2007 to prepare and deliver the 2007-2008 Placer County Assessment Roll to the Auditor-Controller.


It may not be possible to complete the assessment roll by July 1, 2007 for one or more reasons. The following items are contributory to making this request:

- A backlog of reappraisal events associated with finding, appraising and processing about 15,000 residential properties to ensure enrollment of the subject properties at the lesser of market value or factored base year value.
- Approximately 32% of business property statements have not been returned as of May 7, 2007, including many for new businesses. Accurate appraisal of the businesses is time consuming and far from complete.
- Problems associated with our property assessment computer system roll out of a Base Year Tracking Module.
- A backlog of 6,200 appraisals associated with the appraisal of 41,500 events identified year to date. Backlog is related to inability to fill vacant positions and/or the result of under filling many appraisal positions due to failure to attract experienced applicants. Our Chief Appraiser position remains vacant. The Managing Appraiser of our Commercial / Industrial Division is on extended military duty in Afghanistan. A significant number of Senior and Associate Appraiser positions have been vacant throughout the year.


