Subject: Assessment Roll Extension Request

Dear Mr. Hirsig:

Pursuant to Section 155 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, I respectfully request a 30-day extension of time beyond July 1, 2004 to prepare and deliver the 2004-2005 Placer County Assessment Roll to the Auditor-Controller.

It may not be possible to complete the assessment roll by July 1, 2004 for one or more reasons. The following items are contributory to making this request:

- A backlog of reappraisal events to complete associated with processing over 6,500 parcel splits or combinations, as Placer County is again ranked among the fastest growing counties.
- Approximately 53% of business property statements have not been returned as of April 24, 2004, including many for new businesses. Accurate appraisal of the businesses, is time consuming and far from complete.
- A backlog for processing change in ownership documents, caused by an eight (8%) increase in recorded events over the prior year.
- Backlog associated with over 45,000 appraisable events identified year to date. Backlog is related to inability to fill vacant positions and/or the result of under filling many appraisal positions due to failure to attract experienced applicants. Key management positions remain vacant and two more managers will retire before, or during, July 2004.

Your approval of this request is important to completeness and accuracy of the Placer County roll. Thank you for your assistance.

This is a request for a 30-day extension to complete the County of San Diego's 2004 Assessment Roll. This request is being made in accordance with Revenue and Taxation Code Section 155.

Although it is our intention to complete the assessment roll by the mandatory July 1, 2004 date, we have had about 2300 calamity claims as a result of the horrific fires in October which will require us to process values until the last possible date. Ordinarily, we stop processing value changes in early to mid June to allow sufficient time for our computer systems to complete the assessment roll and turn it over to the Auditor and Controller by July 1. Therefore, this extension is being requested to allow for sufficient time to overcome any unforeseen computer difficulties while still processing the maximum amount of value changes prior to the closing of the assessment roll.


