

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

Dear Mr. Hirsig:

As you are aware, Revenue and Taxation Code section 155 provides that a 30-day extension of time for completion of "any act by the assessor" may be granted "by the board or its executive director."

Throughout the 13-plus years that I have served as Assessor it has been my goal never to request such an extension. However, I believe there is now compelling justification indicating that it would be prudent to do so. Therefore, and on the basis of the following considerations, I am requesting the above noted extension, not to exceed 30 days, for completion of the local Sutter County Assessment Roll for 2008-09.

- Responsibility for annual assessment of over 300 gas wells shifted, this year, from an outside contract appraiser to in-house staff, adding significant new work, the bulk of which must be completed in a very short time frame prior to roll close – due to the extremely late (May 7) deadline allowed for submittal by well operators of essential operational and financial data.
- Departmental vacancies in key positions have resulted in shifting of personnel, slowed work processing, and diverted focus of other staff to fill gaps and/or assist in training of new hires.
- Inordinate staff time and resources have been devoted to thousands of Prop 8 reviews and to enrollment of corresponding assessment reductions relating primarily to residential properties.



Dear Mr. Hirsig:

Pursuant to Section 155 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, this office requests a 30-day extension of time to deliver the 2008/2009 Yuba County Assessment Roll.

As you are aware, residential property values in California reached their peak in August 2006 and have been in decline ever since. Yuba County's 2007/08 secured roll contained 736 properties enrolled in accordance with Proposition 8 and section 51 of the Revenue and Taxation Code. For fiscal year 2008/09, it is anticipated that Yuba County will enroll over 6,000 properties pursuant to Proposition 8. This means that approximately one out of every five properties on the secured roll will be enrolled at market value on January 1, 2008 rather than the factored Proposition 13 base year value. We are projecting at this time a decrease in the 2008/09 Assessment Roll from the 2007/08 roll in the range of (-4%) to (-7%).

The appraisal of over 6,000 properties at market value on the lien date January 1, 2008 has created an enormous new workload for the Assessor. Because of a declining market and staffing limitations, we will need a 30-day extension to complete the 2008/09 Assessment Roll.
