


Dear Mr. Hirsig:





Subject: Assessment Roll Extension Request

Dear Mr. Hirsig:

Pursuant to Section 155 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, I respectfully request a 30-day extension of time beyond July 1, 2009 to prepare and deliver the 2009-2010 Placer County Assessment Roll to the Auditor-Controller.

It may not be possible to complete the assessment roll by July 1, 2009 for one or more reasons. The following items are contributory to making this request:

- A backlog of reappraisal events associated with funding, appraising and processing about 50,000 residential properties to ensure enrollment of the subject properties at the lesser of market value or factored base year value.
- A need to allocate additional resources for review of a mix of commercial/industrial properties to determine whether to enroll a factored base or market value.
- Approximately 25% of business property statements have not been returned as of today's date, including many businesses that may have closed due to challenging economic conditions. Accurate appraisal of the businesses is time consuming and far from complete.
- The need to dedicate extended resources on a daily basis to work with hundreds of customers who require explanation of Proposition 13 and Proposition 8 statutory mechanics.





This year, although I would that it were otherwise, I must again request such an extension for closure of the 2009-10 assessment roll, pursuant to Section 155, Revenue and Taxation Code — and not to exceed 30 days beyond July 1, 2009.


Revenue and Taxation Code section 155 provides that a 30 day extension of time for completion of the Roll may be granted by the Board or its executive director.
