
Dear Mr. Hirsig:

Dear Mr. Hirsig:

In accordance with Section 155 of the California Revenue and Taxation code, I hereby respectfully request a 30-day extension in completing the 2008/2009 Assessment Roll due to the following three reasons:

First, as a result of the Angora Fire, June 24, 2007, in South Lake Tahoe, our Section 170 workload delayed commencement of the regular roll work, which normally begins in July. Second, the real estate market value decline has placed an additional workload on staff, which is finishing the review of over 20,000 properties for reassessment under Proposition 8. And third, due to budget cuts imposed on this office, two (2) appraiser positions have been eliminated, with two (2) other positions to be held vacant as of September.

It is for these reasons that this request for extension is necessary. Your consideration of this petition would be greatly appreciated.


