

The Nevada County Assessor's Office has experienced a 27% reduction in staffing, while at the same time, the decline in the residential real estate market and more recently in commercial properties has created an enormous new workload for the Assessor. When the 2011/12 assessment roll is produced, the Assessor estimates that over 17,000 properties or 29% of the secured roll will be assessed in accordance to proposition 8 and Section 51 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.
