

Please consider this letter to be my official request for a thirty (30) day extension to complete this year's assessment roll. As you are aware, almost any county could close the assessment roll timely if they did not "count the cost". We feel the prudent thing to do is to ask for this extension for the following reasons:

- ◆ Avoid costly roll correction process
- ◆ Avoid more confusion to tax paying public by having to explain roll corrections
- ◆ Agricultural statements often come in late (through June 15<sup>th</sup>) allowing little time for proper response coupled with field inspection for verification
  - a) Orchard tree removal
  - b) Improvements (Solid set irrigation system, pumps, wells, agricultural buildings, etc.)
- ◆ Volume of sales and new construction (Both the Chico & Oroville area unfinished work left to complete is comparable to or higher this year than at the same time last year)
- ◆ Clerical staff needs a few days to key all the values once the appraisal work is completed and submitted for processing.





Dear Mr. Hirsig:

Pursuant to Section 155 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, this office requests a 30 Day Extension of Time to deliver the 2005/2006 Yuba County Assessment Roll.

Yuba County is currently experiencing rapid growth. As an example, over the past twenty years the Assessor has added between 200-300 new parcels per year and roll growth has averaged \$80 million per year. This year the Assessor will add over 2,500 new parcels to the assessment roll and the estimated 2005/2006 roll growth will be over \$700 million.

The Assessor's office is currently working with the same amount of allocated positions that was employed by the department in 1980. In addition, due to retirement and terminations the department has had a 40% turnover in staff during fiscal year 2004/05. Currently, five (5) of our allocated seven (7) appraisal positions have five months of experience or less.

Because of the rapid growth occurring in Yuba County and the loss of experienced staff, we will need a 30 day extension to complete the 2005/06 assessment roll.
