Board of Equalization Opens Branch Office in Fairfield

Sacramento - Betty T. Yee, First District Member of the California State Board of Equalization, (BOE) announces that the Board of Equalization has relocated its Suisun City Branch office to Fairfield, where it is now open for taxpayers.

The Fairfield Branch Office provides on-site taxpayer assistance through one-on-one visits and self-service kiosks. “We want to make it easier for our taxpayers to transact business with us,” said Ms. Yee.

The Fairfield Branch Office is ideally situated between Sacramento and the San Francisco Bay Area. Visible from Interstate 80, this office located at [2480 Hilborn Road, Suite 200, Fairfield, CA 94534](#), has ample free parking and is close to the Fairfield-Suisun public transit system making it convenient for taxpayers seeking assistance or wanting to attend in-person workshops.



The Fairfield Branch Office serves BOE taxpayers in Solano, Napa, Yolo, and Colusa counties; managing more than 21,000 taxpayer accounts.

In support of the State of California's environmental stewardship goals, all of the carpet in the office is made from recycled materials, and the modular furniture is refurbished surplus from BOE's Headquarters.
