Sacramento – On Tuesday, February 18, 2014, Board of Equalization (BOE) Chairman Jerome E. Horton will host a free [Small Business Seminar](#) providing small-to-medium-sized businesses with information about millions of dollars in tax credits, refunds, and business loan assistance. Attendees will learn about traditional and nontraditional capital and minimizing the burden of taxation, plus have the opportunity to meet their elected representatives who make decisions that affect small businesses.

The Board recently eliminated the mandatory deposit requirement for some accounts, and will be releasing more than \$145 million in cash, bonds, and guaranties this coming spring.
