Dear Sherrie: I suggest the following BOE 305 Appeal Application Form changes:

- 1) Provide a line(s) for the <> address, C/S/Zip Phone and Fax <> of the agent. If this information is not on the form, for every appeal filed by an agent, someone on the assessor's staff has to make one or more phone calls and write the information somewhere. Throughout the state, this is a major accumulation of time that could be spent doing other, perhaps, more important work.
- 2) At the bottom of Page 1, in the value grid, move the "Trees/Vines" entry above the "Fixtures" line. Perhaps change the title from "Trees/Vines" to "Growing Improvements" ? But I suppose this isn't critical, and the influence of the larger counties who perceive of properties as commercial in nature might outweigh the perception of land/buildings/trees. So, however this works out is OK.
- 3) Change "Mineral Rights" to "Other Assessments" ? After including land, buildings, fixtures, personal property and trees/vines, there is only one line left. A more generic title would allow all other appeals to be entered on this line.
