The petition must be signed by an authorized representative and mailed to: Chief, Board Proceedings Division, MIC:81, State Board of Equalization, PO Box 942879, Sacramento, CA 94279-0081, or deposited personally at the Board's office at 450 N Street, Sacramento. If the 30th day falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or a legal holiday, the time limit is extended to the following business day.
