

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Underground Storage Tank Maintenance Fee Increase Extended Until January 1, 2014

Assembly Bill No. 291 (Wieckowski), Stats. 2011, Ch. 569, amends Health and Safety Code section 25299.43 to extend, for an additional two years, the Underground Storage Tank Maintenance Fee increase of six mil (\$0.006). The fee for petroleum products placed into underground storage tanks will continue to be a total of two cents (\$0.02) per gallon. This increased fee is in effect until January 1, 2014, at which time the fee will revert back to the fourteen mil (\$0.014) rate that was in effect prior to January 1, 2010.

If you are the operator of the underground storage tank and not the owner, we ask that you please contact the owner and advise them of the continued fee increase.
