

1. Take US-101 North toward San Jose
2. Take exit 338C to merge onto 1-880 S toward Los Gatos/Santa Cruz
3. Take exit 2 for The Alameda/CA-82 toward Santa Clara
4. Turn right onto CA-82 North/The Alameda
5. Turn right onto Monroe Street
6. Turn left at the 3rd cross street onto Warburton Avenue

The destination will be on the left

From 101 North

1. Take US-101 South toward San Jose
2. Exit onto San Tomas Expressway
3. Turn left onto Monroe Street
4. Turn right onto Warburton Avenue
