



- Travel west on CA-299
- Turn left to merge onto Interstate 5 south
- Take the Cypress Avenue exit
- Turn right onto Cypress Avenue
The location is on the left

From the Whiskeytown Area:

- Travel east on Highway 299/Eureka Way
- Turn right onto Court Street
- Turn left on Placer Street
- Turn right onto South Market Street
- From the left lane, transition onto Cypress Street
