

Local 1000 is taking aggressive action to fix health & safety problems at BOE Headquarters

- Local 1000 has received scores of complaints about health and safety issues at BOE headquarters stemming from a rash of indoor air quality problems including toxic mold and mildew. The top three floors of the building have been closed, but health problems have been reported on numerous other floors.
 - Despite visible evidence of at least three types of mold, BOE management maintains their tests show air quality to be “better than what is outside”, while employees suffer from unusual respiratory, skin and other potentially severe health conditions.
 - **THURSDAY, November 1**, SEIU’s national director of health and safety, and Local 1000 officials will be inspecting the BOE headquarters for compliance with state laws. Inspections will take place from 10:00am – noon, and again from 1:00pm – 3:00pm.
 - **THURSDAY, November 1**, Local 1000 staff and SEIU health care professionals will meet with BOE employees to answer health-related questions arising from working at the 450 N Street building; meetings will be held from 11:00am – 1:00pm in Room 111.
