I. 2016 LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS

Set forth below are suggestions for legislation to be sponsored by the BOE in the first year of the 2015-16 Legislative Session (see attachments).

BUSINESS TAXES

Suggestion Number_

2-4 Add Revenue and Taxation Code Section 6010.15 of the Sales and Use Tax Law to exclude from the computation of sales or use tax, the transfer of tangible personal property by a pawnbroker back to the person that pledged the property, under specified conditions.

Revenue Impact: Estimated annual state and local revenue loss of \$33.000.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: Adopt (5-0)

Amend Revenue and Taxation Code (RTC) Section 42022 to provide that sellers with de minimis sales of prepaid mobile telephony services (prepaid MTS) are not required to register as prepaid MTS sellers with the Board of Equalization (BOE). Amend RTC Section 42014 to align the prepaid MTS surcharge known-transaction qualifying circumstances to the local prepaid MTS.
