2017 Legislative Proposal: Property Taxes

1-2 Amend Revenue and Taxation Code (RTC) Section 62 to exclude from change in ownership a family farm homestead that has been the continuous home of a child but that is ineligible for the parent-child exclusion after the parent's death due to the complex structure of California property tax law. (Ma)

2017 Legislative Proposal: Business Taxes

2-3 Add Revenue and Taxation Code section 6460 to the Sales and Use Tax Law to allow retailers to report sales tax liability on a cash basis. (Ma)
