LEGISLATIVE CALENDAR

- Jan 31: Last day for each house to pass bills introduced in that house in the odd- numbered year.
- Feb 21: Last day for bills to be introduced.

BILLS OF INTEREST TO THE BOE

- AB 576 (Nazarian): State Board of Equalization: Transfer of duties.
 - January 23: Assembly Appropriations Committee, Held Under Submission.
- ACA 2 (Nazarian): Assembly Revenue and Taxation committee.
 - Active bill
 - No hearing date scheduled

INTRODUCED THIS MONTH

- AB 1959 (Mayes), Property Tax Assessment Appeals. Provides that when a property owner appeals an assessment, the date on which the taxes are due and payable must be tolled during the pendency of the appeal. Vote: Majority.
- AB 1977 (Bonta), Museum Property Tax Welfare Exemption. Prohibits an assessor from denying a claim for the welfare exemption for a property that is used exclusively for the charitable purposes of museums. Vote: Majority.

BOE'S PROPOSED LEGISLATION

- Senate Governance and Finance Committee has agreed to take BOE's four technical proposals and put them into a Committee Omnibus bill.
