Discussion and possible action for support of [SB 288 \(Seyarto\)](#). Under various provisions of the Revenue and Taxation Code relating to taxation, this bill would specify that the one-year period to claim an intergenerational transfer change in ownership

exclusion is deemed to commence on the effective date of a probate court's determination of the final ownership of property.

Discussion and possible action for support of [SB 974 \(Seyarto\)](#). Under various provisions of the Revenue and Taxation Code relating to taxation, this bill would modify the definition of "transfer" in statute implementing Proposition 19 to explicitly state that other forms of trusts can qualify for the exclusion, specifically Special Needs Trusts.

Under various provisions of the Revenue and Taxation Code relating to taxation, this bill would provide that a property damaged or destroyed in a Governor-declared disaster that is subsequently rebuilt can maintain its pre-disaster base year value if the size of the reconstructed property is 110% of the size of the damaged or destroyed property.
