



Pursuant to Section 155 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, I respectfully request a 30-day extension of time beyond July 1, 2011, to prepare and deliver the 2011-2012 Sonoma County Secured and Unsecured Assessment Rolls to the Auditor-Controller.

Dear Ms. Cazadd:

As you are probably aware, the State Board of Equalization granted an extension of time for completion of last year's (2010-11) assessment roll for Sutter County.

Once again, it is necessary to request additional time for completion of the roll. Accordingly, and pursuant to Section 155 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, I respectfully request an extension of the 2011-12 assessment roll, not to exceed thirty (30) days beyond July 1, 2011.

The requested extension is again based upon circumstances effectively the same as those existing in the prior fiscal year – an excessive volume of Prop 8 reviews from last year's roll and the new ones since then, both totaling over 26% of the counties total number of parcels. Although this office has undergone steps to improve our efficiency and utilized mass appraisal techniques, the actual valuation work must be held beyond the lien date in order to gather, verify and analyze the comparable data. Added to this burden were the in-house gas well valuations and the excessive absences of an appraiser due to illness and ability only to work 2/3 of the year. Therefore, it will be necessary to request an extension of the roll.

I thank you for your time and consideration and will make myself available at your convenience, should you or any member of your staff have questions or concerns regarding this request.



Revenue and Taxation Code section 155 provides that a 30 day extension of time for completion of the Roll may be granted by the Board or its executive director.

With the downturn of the housing market, the valuation review and data entry of a huge number of Proposition 8 properties has significantly impacted our workload. We anticipate reviewing nearly half of the residential properties in Yolo County. Since the downturn of the economy, the number of assessment appeals has continued to be about 5 times normal.

Staffing was hit hard. Budget constraints have left us more than 13% short of staff this year, and remaining staff were subject to furlough and voluntary time off.

At this time we are still hoping to close the Roll on time but think it advisable to request the 30 day extension in case it becomes necessary. Thank you for your time and consideration. Please contact me if you have any questions regarding this request.
