STATE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION 1 TELECONFERENCE 2 MARCH 22, 2022 3 -----4 MS. COHEN: Thank you. 5 All right. Let's go live. 6 MS. TAYLOR: All right. 7 Ms. -- Chair Cohen, you may begin. 8 AT&T OPERATOR: Test, one, two, three. 9 MS. COHEN: Thank you very much. 10 I'm sorry, I'm just --11 Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. 12 It is March 22nd. It is 10:04 a.m. 13 I hope everyone is doing very well. 14 I would like to begin this meeting. 15 Just one second. I'm loading up my meeting 16 notes. 17 All right. Thank you, Ms. Taylor. 18 We are ready to call this meeting in 19 order -- to order. 20 Please call the roll. 21 MS. TAYLOR: Good morning. 22 It looks like there's still confusion on the 23 sound. 24 AT&T operator, can you confirm that this 25 meeting is live? 26 AT&T operator, can you please confirm that 27 our meeting is live? 28

Excuse me, Members. We'll have to resolve 1 this technical difficulty here. 2 AT&T operator, can you please confirm when 3 we are ready to go live? 4 MS. FLEMING: Chair Cohen and Members, 5 Vice Chair Schaefer is having a technical issue. 6 We're working with him to get it resolved as quickly 7 as possible. And as soon as we have him dialed in, 8 we'll be ready to. 9 MS. COHEN: Okay. 10 MS. TAYLOR: Yes. 11 And, Ms. Fleming, we're still having trouble 12 with AT&T. So we'll need to resolve that as well. 13 My apologies. 14 MS. FLEMING: Okay. Thank you. 15 Members, thank you for your patience. 16 Please feel free to mute your mics. 17 Thank you. 18 AT&T MODERATOR: Yes, we are live now. 19 MS. TAYLOR: Good morning. 20 This is a test of our system to see if the 21 public can hear the live feed of this meeting. 22 Also a test for the closed captioner to 23 begin. 24 AT&T operator, are the lines bridged? 25 And -- because we're not hearing a feed out in the 26 live webcast. 27 Good morning. This is a test of the AT&T 28

public line to see if the public can hear our feed. 1 Thank you. 2 This is another test of the Board Meeting 3 live feed. 4 I would like to ask the closed captioner to 5 begin to take captioning in order to confirm this 6 test. 7 MS. FLEMING: Members, again, thank you for 8 your patience. 9 (Thereupon a break was taken.) 10 MS. TAYLOR: This is another test. 11 We are continuing to resolve to have 12 separate captioning. And we hope that will be 13 resolved by the time the Members return from their 14 Closed Session. 15 MS. COHEN: All right. Well, let's go ahead 16 and begin. 17 Ms. Taylor, could you please call the roll. 18 MS. TAYLOR: Certainly. 19 Chair Cohen. 20 MS. COHEN: Present. 21 MS. TAYLOR: Vice Chair Schaefer. 22 MR. SCHAEFER: Present. 23 MS. TAYLOR: Member Gaines. 24 MR. GAINES: Here. 25 MS. TAYLOR: Member Vazquez. 26 MR. VAZQUEZ: Present. 27 MS. TAYLOR: Deputy Controller Stowers. 28

MS. STOWERS: Present. 1 MS. COHEN: Okay. A quorum is present. 2 MS. TAYLOR: A quorum is present. 3 MS. COHEN: And the Board is now called to 4 order. 5 It is 10:39 on March 22nd, 2022. 6 We'll start with The Pledge of Allegiance. 7 If you're able, please join me by standing 8 and placing your right hand over your heart. 9 (Whereupon The Pledge of Allegiance was 10 recited.) 11 MS. COHEN: Okay. Just a reminder to 12 everyone that all Members and the invited speakers 13 are simultaneously on a shared, open conference call 14 And as you can see, patience is needed to keep line. 15 the audio clean and clear. 16 So we ask for your -- we ask for your return 17 to speak after each presentation has concluded, so 18 that the transcriptionist can clearly hear and 19 properly record the meeting. 20 Thank you. 21 Colleagues, I'd like to see if there are any 22 comments or any remarks that you'd like to make 23 before we take our first order of business. 24 Okay. Seeing none --25 MR. GAINES: If I could. 26 MS. COHEN: Oh, yes. Please. 27 MR. GAINES: Yeah. Thank you. 28

I'd just like to comment in reference to 1 what's happened in the Ukraine. 2 And our prayers are with the people in 3 Ukraine, and the huge challenges that they're 4 suffering. And to see a democracy be attacked in 5 such a brutal way by Putin is just horrific. 6 And so I think this is a very important time 7 that we, as Americans, are steadfast and work 8 together on a bipartisan basis to make sure that we 9 can do everything that's practical to help Ukraine, 10 and all at the same time being cautious. 11 Thank you. 12 MS. COHEN: You're welcome. 13 Colleagues, or anyone else have any remarks 14 that they'd like to share? 15 All right. Ms. Taylor, could you please 16 announce our first order of business. 17 MS. TAYLOR: Our first order of business 18 today is an announcement regarding public 19 teleconference participation. 20 Good morning and thank you for joining 21 today's Board of Equalization Meeting via 22 teleconference. 23 Throughout the duration of today's meeting, 24 you will primarily be in a listen-only mode. 25 As you may know from our Public Agenda 26 Notice and our website, we have requested that 27 individuals who wish to make a public comment fill 28

out the "public comment" submission form found on our 1 "additional information" web page in advance of 2 today's meeting; or, alternatively, participate in 3 today's meeting by providing your public comment 4 live. 5 After the presentation of an item has 6 concluded, we will begin by identifying any public 7 comment requests that have been received by our 8 Board Proceedings staff, with the AT&T operator 9 providing directions for you to identify yourself. 10 After all known public commenters have been 11 called, the operator will also provide public comment 12 instructions to those individuals participating via 13 teleconference. 14 Accordingly, if you intend to make a public 15 comment today, we recommend dialing into the meeting 16 on the teleconference line, as the audio broadcast on 17 our website experiences a one-to-three minute delay. 18 If giving a public comment, please limit 19 your remarks to three minutes. 20 We ask can that everyone who is not 21 intending to make a public comment to please mute 22 their line. 23 If there are technical difficulties when we 24 are in the public comment portion of our meeting, we 25 will do our best to read submitted comments into the 26 record at appropriate times. 27 Thank you for your patience and 28

understanding. 1 MS. COHEN: Thank you for reading that 2 announcement. 3 Ms. Taylor, please call our first agenda 4 item. 5 ITEM N 6 7 MS. TAYLOR: The first agenda item is N, 8 Public Comment on Matters Not on the Agenda; Persons 9 who wish to address the Board of Equalization 10 regarding items not on the agenda. 11 Please note that the Board cannot take 12 action; however, the Board can schedule issues raised 13 by the public for consideration at future meetings. 14 AT&T operator, can you let us know if there 15 is anyone on the line who would like to make a public 16 comment regarding this item. 17 AT&T MODERATOR: Thank you. 18 No one has queued up. 19 MS. TAYLOR: Thank you. 20 MS. COHEN: All right. Since there's no 21 public comment, Ms. Taylor, could you please call our 22 next agenda item. 23 ITEM O 24 25 26 MS. TAYLOR: Certainly. 27 Our next item is O, Closed Session; 28 Discussion and action on personnel matters.

The Board Members will now go into Closed 1 Session to discuss personnel matters. 2 MS. COHEN: Thank you. 3 MS. TAYLOR: Members, you may exit this 4 meeting and enter a Closed-Session meeting. 5 MS. FLEMING: Thank you, Ms. Taylor. 6 Just to reiterate, Members, we're going to 7 please make sure you fully exit from the public 8 meeting. 9 There's a second link for the 10 Closed Session. Please use that link to join the 11 Closed-Session portion of it, and then we will resume 12 afterwards back in this public meeting. 13 So we'll see you in Closed Session. 14 Thank you, Members. 15 (Thereupon Closed Session began.) 16 MS. TAYLOR: The Board Members met in 17 Closed Session and discussed personnel matters. 18 MS. COHEN: Yes. Thank you very much. 19 May I have a motion not to disclose what was 20 discussed in Closed Session? 21 MR. VAZQUEZ: So moved. 22 MS. COHEN: Thank you. 23 Motion made by Mr. Vazquez. 24 Is there a second? 25 MR. GAINES: Second. 26 MS. COHEN: Second by Mr. Gaines. 27 Please call the roll. 28

MS. TAYLOR: Chair Cohen. 1 MS. COHEN: Aye. 2 MS. TAYLOR: Vice Chair Schaefer. 3 MR. SCHAEFER: Aye. 4 MS. TAYLOR: Member Gaines. 5 MR. GAINES: Aye. 6 MS. TAYLOR: Member Vazquez. 7 MR. VAZQUEZ: Aye. 8 MS. TAYLOR: Deputy Controller Stowers. 9 Deputy Controller Stowers, do you vote? 10 MS. COHEN: Okay. I don't think she can 11 hear us. 12 MR. VAZQUEZ: She probably abstains. Yeah. 13 MS. COHEN: So let's keep moving. 14 We have a quorum. We have a -- votes. 15 So, Ms. Taylor, I'd like to adjourn this 16 meeting at 12:44 p.m. 17 Colleagues, thank you. I look forward to 18 seeing you and speaking with you on our next 19 regularly-scheduled meeting, which will be 20 March 30th. 21 All right. Thank you, everyone. Have a 22 good day. Goodbye. 23 MR.
