COHEN: Ladies and gentlemen, good 5 6 morning. 7 I'd like to call this meeting to order. It is March 30th, 2022. It's 10:02 in the 8 morning. And we are ready to reconvene our Board of 9 10 Equalization Meeting. Ms. Taylor, could you please call the roll. 11 12 MS. TAYLOR: Certainly. 13 Chair Cohen. MS. COHEN: Present. 14 MS. TAYLOR: Vice Chair Schaefer. 15 MR. SCHAEFER: Present. 16 MS. TAYLOR: Member Gaines. 17 MR. GAINES: Present. 18 MS. TAYLOR: Member Vazquez. 19 MR. VAZQUEZ: Present. 20 21 MS. TAYLOR: Deputy Controller Stowers. 22 MS. STOWERS: Present. 23 MS. TAYLOR: A quorum is present. 24 MS. COHEN: Great. Thank you. 25 Are there any announcements, colleagues?

Do you have any announcements you'd like to 1 2 make? No? 3 All right. Seeing none, a quorum is 4 present, and the Board Meeting is called to order. 5 6 And just as a reminder to everyone that all Board Members and invited speakers are simultaneously 7 8 on a shared, open teleconference call line, and patience is needed to keep the audio clean and clear. 9 Thank you. 10 All right. Colleagues, if you have no other 11 12 comments or remarks before we take up our first order 13 of business, we will proceed. Ms. Taylor, please announce our first order 14 of business. 15 MS. TAYLOR: Our first order of business is 16 an announcement regarding public teleconference 17 18 participation. Good morning and thank you for joining 19 today's Board of Equalization meeting via 20 teleconference. 21 Throughout the duration of today's meeting, 22 you will primarily be in a listen-only mode. 23 24 As you may know from our Public Agenda 25 Notice on our website, we have requested that

individuals who wish to make a public comment fill 1 2 out the public comment submission form found on our "additional information" webpage in advance of 3 today's meeting. 4 Or, alternatively, participate in today's 5 6 meeting by providing your public comment live. and approval. 1 2 Thank you. It's 3:45. I believe we can now call this 3 meeting adjourned. 4 Ms. Taylor, do we need to take any further 5 action? 6 7 MS. TAYLOR: No, ma'am. We are ready to 8 adjourn at your queue. MS. COHEN: All right. Thank you. 9 Thank you for your service, everyone. 10 MR. NANJO: Sorry, Chairperson Cohen. 11 12 This is Henry Nanjo, Chief Counsel. 13 The only piece I wasn't aware -- sure of is, when is the appointment effective? 14 Is there a date or --15 MS. COHEN: There's no date effective yet. 16 It's all subject to CalHR's review and approval. 17 MR. NANJO: Okay. Thank you for the 18 clarification. My apologies for interrupting. 19 MS.
