(Redding) Acting BOE Member Barbara Alby speaks at the Upstate California Small Business Tax and Regional Opportunities Seminar on Tuesday, May 4 at 9:30 a.m. at the Redding City Council Chambers, 777 Cypress Avenue, Redding.

Alby will invite small business owners to take advantage of the Board's resources to navigate the state's tax rules and encourage people to contact her for help.

Alby said, "In this economy the role small businesses have for creating jobs and prosperity cannot be overstated. The last thing new businesses need is to be in trouble with the state's tax agencies. I am here to help," Alby said.

Barbara Alby, of Sacramento, became Acting Board Member for the Second Equalization District in March, 2010. Prior to becoming Acting Member, she served as the Chief Deputy to Second District Board Member Bill Leonard. She also served in the State Assembly from 1993 to 1998, representing the Sacramento area.

The five-member California State Board of Equalization (BOE) is a publicly elected tax board. The BOE collects more than \$53 billion annually in taxes and fees supporting state and local government services. It hears business tax appeals, acts as the appellate body for franchise and personal income tax appeals, and serves a significant role in the assessment and administration of property taxes.
