## **San Diego and San Marcos Board of Equalization Offices To Open at Noon Today**

*El Centro Office Closed Until Monday*

Board of Equalization offices in San Diego and San Marcos will reopen for business at noon today. Those offices were closed late yesterday due to the widespread power outage in the area.

Minimal staff will be available to assist taxpayers with in-office needs such as obtaining a sellers' permit or assistance with their business accounts. These offices will offer full service on Monday.

The El Centro office will remain closed until Monday. Taxpayers in the El Centro area who need assistance should call the toll free BOE number, 800-400-7115.

These three BOE offices employ approximately 135 BOE staff.

The five-member California State Board of Equalization (BOE) is a publicly elected tax board. The BOE collects more than \$50 billion annually in taxes and fees supporting state and local government services. It hears business tax appeals, acts as the appellate body for franchise and personal income tax appeals, and serves a significant role in the assessment and administration of property taxes.
