BETTY T. YEE RELEASES ASSESSMENT PRACTICES SURVEY REPORT FOR DEL NORTE COUNTY

Sacramento - Betty T. Yee, First District Member of the California State Board of Equalization (BOE), today released the Del Norte County Assessment Practices Survey Report. The report focuses on the quality of the 2009-10 Del Norte County assessment roll, representing approximately \$1.7 billion in value.

The Del Norte County Assessment Practices Survey Report states that most properties in Del Norte County are assessed properly, and the overall quality of the assessment roll meets state standards. The survey report notes 11 recommendations for improvement to the Del Norte County Assessor's programs and includes the Del Norte County Assessor's response to the BOE's recommendations. The BOE is the agency responsible for promoting statewide uniformity and consistency in property tax assessment, reviewing each county's property assessment practices and procedures once every five years and publishing an assessment practices survey report.

The report provides an overview of how well the assessor's duties are performed and identifies where improvements should be made. Every assessor is required to identify and assess all properties located within the county – unless specifically exempt – and maintain a database or "roll" of the properties and their assessed values. If the assessor's roll meets state requirements, the county is allowed to recapture some administrative costs.
