BOE to Hold September Board Meeting in San Francisco
Board Makes Meetings More Accessible to Californians

Sacramento – The California State Board of Equalization (BOE) will hold its September 10, 2013 Board meeting at the California Public Utilities Commission located at 505 Van Ness Avenue in San Francisco.

The scheduled San Francisco meeting is part of the Board’s efforts to engage more business owners and taxpayers in the public process by making its monthly meetings more accessible to Californians throughout the state. The BOE generally holds its monthly meetings at its headquarters in Sacramento or at its Culver City office.

Public meetings offer tax and feepayers the opportunity to participate in public hearings regarding formulation or amendment of rules and regulations. This public forum also affords tax and feepayers an opportunity to present their cases to the Board which is the appellate body that reviews and decides property, business, and personal income tax determinations.
