Board of Equalization and County Property Tax Assessors Meet in San Rafael

Sacramento – The California State Board of Equalization (BOE) will hold its annual meeting with the state’s county assessors on Tuesday, November 18, 2014, at 101 McInnis Parkway in San Rafael. The meeting convenes at 1:30 p.m.

This year’s meeting will feature a panel discussion focused on strengthening relationships between county assessors and the Board to meet common goals. It will also include updates on recently decided court cases that impact property tax assessment, as well as information for requesting legal opinions from the Board’s Legal Department. State law requires the BOE to meet with assessors at least once a year to discuss issues related to the administration of property tax assessment and taxation laws, and focus on matters to promote uniformity of procedures and assessment in property taxation throughout California.
