YEE ANNOUNCES FREE TAX SEMINAR FOR NONPROFIT AND EXEMPT ORGANIZATIONS IN DAVIS AND SURROUNDING AREAS

Betty T. Yee, Chairwoman of the California State Board of Equalization (BOE), Senator Mike Machado, and Assemblymember Lois Wolk are sponsoring a free one-day tax seminar to assist nonprofit and exempt organizations in Davis and surrounding areas.
