BOARD OF EQUALIZATION COMPLETES TOP 250 TAX DEBTOR LIST

The Board of Equalization added 24 names to its list of top sales tax debtors today.

Because of difficulties notifying several dozen taxpayers, the Board's original list in April only included 226 names. Recent legislation directs the Board to post the largest 250 tax debts outside of appeal, litigation, or bankruptcy proceedings.

Five taxpayers took care of their debts before their names were posted, four through payment agreements and one by making payment in full. Their accounts represent \$2.6 million dollars in state and local sales tax.

The list will be updated quarterly.

The five-member Board of Equalization is a publicly elected tax board. The Board collects nearly \$53 billion annually in taxes and fees supporting state and local government services. It hears business tax appeals, acts as the appellate body for franchise and personal income tax appeals, and plays a significant role in the assessment and administration of property taxes.
