BETTY T. YEE ANNOUNCES FREE TAX SEMINAR FOR NONPROFIT AND EXEMPT ORGANIZATIONS IN SAN MATEO AND SURROUNDING AREAS

Betty T. Yee, Chairwoman of the State Board of Equalization (BOE), is sponsoring a free one-day tax seminar to assist nonprofit and exempt organizations in the San Mateo County area.

Yee encourages those responsible for nonprofit and exempt organizations to attend and learn how tax laws and reporting requirements affect their operations. Topics include recent developments in charity law, lobbying activities by nonprofit and exempt organizations, property tax exemptions, employment taxes, sales taxes and other relevant tax laws for nonprofits.

Experts from the BOE, the Employment Development Department, the Franchise Tax Board, the Internal Revenue Service, the Office of the Attorney General, and the Alliance for Justice have been invited to assist attendees.
