YEE ANNOUNCES FIRST BOE MEETING BROADCAST

Board of Equalization (BOE) Chairwoman Betty T. Yee announced the February 27 Board meeting would be the first to include a live audio broadcast over the internet.

“This move allows us to serve a broader audience throughout the state and provides greater transparency of this publicly-elected commission,” said Chairwoman Yee.

The Board meets each month in Sacramento and several times a year in the Los Angeles area, where it hears taxpayer appeals, considers regulatory actions, and hears reports from executives of the 3,800-person state agency it oversees.

The Board is also looking to make audio recordings available online shortly.

Chairwoman Betty T. Yee was elected to her post in November 2006. Her district includes many of California’s coastal counties, from Del Norte to Santa Barbara, and includes the entire San Francisco Bay Area.

The Board collects nearly \$53 billion annually in taxes and fees supporting state and local government services. It hears business tax appeals, acts as the appellate body for franchise and personal income tax appeals, and plays a significant role in the assessment and administration of property taxes.
