TO COUNTY ASSESSORS:

SB 239, CRAVEN (CHAPTER 4, STATUTES OF 1979)

On February 27, 1979 the Governor signed SB 239, Craven (Chapter 4, Statutes of 1979). This bill permits the placement of non-homeowner possessory interests on the secured roll in all counties, irrespective of population.

The provisions of this bill will be of most interest to those counties which levied the 1977-78 secured roll tax rate on the 1978-79 unsecured roll. AB 2463, Suitt (Chapter 576, Statutes of 1978) allowed those counties to place such possessory interests on the secured roll for 1978-79 only. In counties of over 4 million in population this option has always been available.

The authority to place these properties on the secured roll rests with the local boards of supervisors.
