HOMEOWNERS' EXEMPTION TERMINATION NOTICE
MAILED WITH TAX BILL

Assembly Bill 199 (Chapter 65, Statutes of 1979) was signed by the Governor Saturday, May 19, 1979. The major provisions follow:

1. Amends Section 255.3 of the Revenue and Taxation Code:
 - a. Provides for the mailing of a claim form on or before March 15 by the assessor.
 - b. Deletes the prior requirement that the assessor mail the termination notice.
2. Deletes Section 255.4 which required that information under the Gonsalves-Deukmejian-Petris Senior Citizens Property Tax Relief Act be included in the claim form and termination notice.
3. Added Section 2615.5 which provides that the tax bill or a copy thereof shall be accompanied by a notice concerning ineligibility for the homeowners' exemption.

You can expect the revised homeowners' claim form for use in 1980, along with other revised exemption forms, by October 1979.
