Runner Announces FTB Interested Parties Meeting on Tribal Residency

SACRAMENTO – The Franchise Tax Board has announced an interested parties meeting regarding how to determine whether a Tribal Member is “living on” or “living off” his or her own tribe’s reservation for purposes of California personal income tax.

“This is a very important issue for tribal members,” said George Runner. “It is critical that this issue be clarified so that there is a clear standard to evaluate residency for tribal members.”

The meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, September 18th at 1:30 PM. It will be held in the Franchise Tax Board’s Goldberg Auditorium:
