Important Notice

Effective July 1, 2007, Sales or Leases of Portable DVD Players Are Subject to the Electronic Waste Recycling (Ewaste) Fee

Beginning July 1, 2007, retailers who sell or lease new or refurbished portable DVD players that include a liquid crystal display (LCD) measuring more than four inches diagonally will be required to collect and report the Ewaste fee on these devices. Established in 2005, the Ewaste fee applies to sales and leases of new or refurbished video display devices known as covered electronic devices (CEDs), such as televisions with LCD, plasma or cathode ray tube displays, computer monitors, laptop computers, and other video display devices. The fee ranges from \$6.00 to \$10.00 per CED sold, depending upon the size of the screen. Retailers are permitted to retain three percent of the Ewaste fees collected to cover their administrative costs.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) may add electronic devices that they determine contain hazardous substances to the list of CEDs annually.

If your retail business operation involves the sale or lease of these electronic devices, you are required to be registered under the Ewaste Program. To help us update our records, please complete and return the following information.

If you are required to collect the Ewaste fee, the Board will register your business and send you an acknowledgement letter with your new Ewaste account number. If you are not required to register for this program, we will update your Sales and Use Tax Account information to indicate that you do not make sales or leases of CEDs.
