



FROM THE DOWNTOWN LOS ANGELES AREA

- Take I-10 East (Exit 28)
- Take the Santa Anita Avenue exit
- Continue straight onto Asher Street
- Turn right onto Tyler Avenue
- Turn left onto Bodger Street

Parking lot entrance will be on the left

FROM THE WEST COVINA AREA

- Take the I-10 West (Exit 29A)
- Take the Peck Road South exit
- Turn right onto Peck Road
- Turn right onto Garvey Avenue
- Turn right onto Tyler Avenue
- Turn left onto Bodger Street
